

## Look UP

Can you find the ARCADE? When was it built?

Can you find a ship in a bottle? *Clue*: Look for a flint fronted shop. This building is the only remaining part of the ANCHOR BREWERY, which was founded by the Constable family in the 1800s. Found it? What colour are the sails on the ship?

Cross the road at the crossing near the CLOCK TOWER. Stand with your back to the Bakery and face the opposite side of the road. Look up! Can you find where COLLISS & SONS used to be? What sort of business did they have?

This is what is known as a 'ghost sign', an old handpainted sign for a business which no longer exists preserved on a building.

Can you find some carved flowers above a Resturant? This grand building used to be a Bank, can you find another Bank in the High Street with carved flowers above it?

## Look DOWN

Can you find some colourful underwater art on the pavement? Find the piece with the octopus, how many bottles are floating around him?

All these bottles are part of the Museum's collection. Constable's were once the largest employer in Littlehampton. Their huge brewery was on the site by Anchor Springs Bus Stop. Apart from the shop front you spotted earlier, it was all pulled down in the 1970s.
